

BY-LAW NO. 238

**A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF OROMOCTO
TO LICENSE AMUSEMENT DEVICES**

BE IT ENACTED by the
Mayor and Councillors
of the Town of Oromocto
as follows:

1. In this by-law “amusement device” means a machine contrivance or device that,
 - a) upon insertion therein of any money or other article
 - i) provides or may provide to the operator thereof any amusement or recreation, or
 - ii) may be used by the operator for the purpose of playing a game of skill, and
 - b) a machine commonly known as a nickelodeon or music vending machine.
2.
 - (1) Any person who has within the Town in his possession or on any premises occupied by him any amusement device shall each year obtain a license, hereinafter called an “amusement device license”, with respect to such amusement device.
 - (2) An application for an amusement device license with respect to each amusement device shall be made in writing to the Town Clerk
 - (3) An applicant shall in his application state:
 - (a) his name and address; and
 - (b) a description of the amusement device with respect to which the application is made and the serial number thereof, if any.
 - (4) The Town Clerk shall, upon payment of the license fee, issue to the applicant of an amusement device license for the amusement device described therein.
 - (5) The fee payable to the Town for an amusement device license shall be ten dollars.
3.
 - (1) Every amusement device license shall expire on the thirty-first day of December in the year in which it is issued.
 - (2) When it is established to his satisfaction that an amusement device for which a license is in effect has been replaced by an amusement device of substantially the same kind, the Town Clerk upon written application setting out such fact and such information as is required upon an application for a license under subsection (3) of section 2, and upon receipt of a fee of one dollar and surrender of such amusement device license, shall issue a license for the amusement device replacing the amusement device for which a license has been surrendered.
4. Every person who has within the Town in his possession or in any premises occupied by him an amusement device shall keep affixed thereto a valid and subsisting amusement device license issued with respect to such amusement device.

5. Every person who violates any provision of this By-Law is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars and not more than one hundred dollars and in default of payment is subject to imprisonment in accordance with Section 31. (3) and amendments thereto of the Summary Convictions Act.
