

BY-LAW 319-C
**A BY-LAW TO AMEND “A BY-LAW RELATING TO HIGHWAYS, SIDEWALKS,
PARKS, PUBLIC PARKING LOTS AND PUBLIC SPACES
IN THE TOWN OF OROMOCTO”**

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor
and Councillors of the Town of
Oromocto as follows:

By-Law 319, “A By-Law Relating to Highways, Sidewalks, Parks, Public Parking Lots and Public Spaces in the Town of Oromocto” is amended by adding i. to Section 1; and Sections 5.1, 5.2 and Schedule “B” as follows:

DEFINITIONS

1. In this By-Law:
 - i. “Truck” means every commercial vehicle designed, used or maintained primarily for the transportation of property of 4500 kg or greater vehicle weight.

DESIGNATED COMMERCIAL TRUCKING ROUTES

- 5.1 Trucks operating on Town streets are restricted to the designated trucking routes as depicted in the attached Schedule “B”, excepting those in direct service of a business or household only accessible from that route.

PENALTY

- 5.2 Any person operating a truck or owner who fails to comply with provision 5.1 of this By-law, is guilty of an offence and is voluntarily liable to, or upon summary conviction is liable to, a fine of one hundred and twenty-five dollars (\$125.00) for each offence. Upon voluntary payment by the person committing the violation of the above prescribed fine; that person is not liable to be prosecuted therefor.
