

In an effort to divert the volume of waste materials from the landfill, The Town of Oromocto will offer a leaf curbside collection of all residential households.

Acceptable Materials

Leaves **ONLY** in clear polyethylene plastic bags of 1.5 ml thickness with a maximum capacity of 55 litres securely tied at the top and not exceeding 20 kg (44 lbs) per bag.

Please do not place leaves at curbside in advance of the 03 November and not after the 14 November collection period.

Yard waste can also be taken to the Fredericton Region Solid Waste Commission (1775 Alison Blvd.) during its normal hours of operation Mon-Fri 7:30am – 5:00pm & Saturday 7:30 am - 3:00pm.
