## **BY-LAW 419** A BY-LAW RELATING TO THE STOPPING UP AND CLOSING OF STREETS WITHIN THE TOWN OF OROMOCTO

- 3. By-Law 251, A By-Law to Close Certain Public Streets in the Town of Oromocto, and all amendments thereto, is hereby repealed.


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## **SCHEDULE "A"**
