and other material; Develop a training week and in-service training opportunities for staff; Ensure that staff maintain a daily record of the number of visitors and submit data to Supervisor monthly; Ensure that staff maintain the general cleanliness of the Oromocto VIC; Attend training seminars as required; Liaise with local industry partners and ensure literature distribution to significant venues within Oromocto; Maintain literature kiosks; Create and maintain a 3-person shift schedule for the summer and deal with any employment related issues as they arise; Facilitate the delivery of the Department of Tourism & Parks Operator Self-Service and Intercept Programme service; Develop a month-end and season-end report; and perform other duties relating to the position.



Recreation & Tourism student casual positions require that the applicant be a full-time student in the 2019-20 school year and entering or currently enrolled in a post-secondary institution for Fall 2020, or as defined by a third party employment funding program.
