Splash Pad Ambassador

*Applications for this summer student position(s) within the Recreation and Tourism Department will be received at the Oromocto Municipal Offices until **4:00pm, Friday, 30 April 2021.***

Minimum Qualifications: Entering Second Year of University or Equivalent; Class 5 driver's license.

Hours of Work: This position requires the employee to perform duties as part of a shift work team, providing services to the community 7 days per week. Full and part time shifts are available.

Function: Under the supervision of the Program & Special Event Officer, carries out the duties required to maintain a high standard of maintenance for splash pad and park facilities under the control of the Recreation & Tourism Department.

Responsible to: Program & Special Event Officer

Responsibilities: Monitor the splash pads, follow the operational plan, and ensure users respect the COVID-19 measures. Perform regular maintenance, cleaning and sanitizing of the comfort station. Perform general daily preparation and operation of the splash pad systems. Inspect the splash pad and surround areas, clean any debris and litter, and report any issues.
