Candidates may be nominated for any of the following awards:

- CARRIE HOWE VOLUNTEER SERVICE AWARD
- BUSINESS SERVICE AWARD
- PROVINCIAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARD
- ATLANTIC / MARITIME AWARD
- NATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARD
- INTERNATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

NOMINATION GUIDELINES

- 1) Nominations will be accepted on the prescribed forms supplied by the Department of Recreation and Tourism.
- 2) Individual nominations will be screened in order to verify credentials.
- 3) Nominations cannot be made by a Municipal Councillor or a relative of the candidate.
- 4) Individuals can receive recognition for more than one activity per category.
- 5) Individual candidates must reside within the Town of Oromocto.
- 6) If an organization or team representing Oromocto successfully meets the Guidelines for Nomination, all team members (both Resident and Non-Resident) would qualify for the award.

NOMINATION CRITERIA

CARRIE HOWE VOLUNTEER SERVICE AWARD

This Award is to be presented to an individual or group who make an outstanding contribution as a volunteer in recreation or sport in the community.

Guidelines for Nomination

- 1) Candidates who receive salaries or financial rewards as a result of their contribution will be ineligible for the award.
- 2) Selection will be made by the Recreation and Tourism Committee.
- 3) Candidates must reside within the Town of Oromocto or be a member of an organization or team based in, or representing Oromocto.

BUSINESS SERVICE AWARD

This Award is to be presented to a local business that makes an outstanding contribution in support of recreation or sport in the community.

Guidelines for Nomination

- 1) Businesses that receive a financial reward as a result of their volunteer contribution will be ineligible for this award.
- 2) Selection for this award will be made by the Recreation and Tourism Committee.
- 3) The business must be located within the Town of Oromocto or support an organization or team representing Oromocto.

PROVINCIAL LEVEL AWARD

This Award is to be presented to a group or individual who excels at a Provincial Level of recreation or sport activity.

Guidelines for Nomination

The candidate(s) must have achieved one of the following:

- 1) Achieved a first place standing in an activity at the Provincial Championship.
- 2) Earned a place on a Provincial team.
- 3) Been selected to a Provincial Board or Committee.

ATLANTIC – MARITIME AWARD

This Award will be presented to a group or individual who excels at the Atlantic or Maritime Level of recreation or sport activity.

Guidelines for Nomination

The candidate(s) must have achieved one of the following:

- 1) Achieved a first place standing in an activity at the Atlantic Maritime Championship.
- 2) Earned a birth on an Atlantic or Maritime Team.
- 3) Been selected to an Atlantic or Maritime Board or Committee.

NATIONAL LEVEL AWARD

This Award will be presented to a group or individual who excels at a National Level of recreation or sport activity.

Guidelines for Nomination

The candidate(s) must have achieved one of the following:

- 1) Achieved a high standing in an activity at the National Level; be it a first, second or third place finish.
- 2) By earning a birth on a National Team.
- 3) Been selected to a National Board or Committee.

INTERNATIONAL LEVEL AWARD

This Award will be presented to a group or individual who excels at an International Level of recreation or sport activity.

Guidelines for Nomination

The candidate(s) must have achieved one of the following:

- 1) Achieved a high standing in an activity at the International Level; be it a first, second or third place finish.
- 2) Must be a member of a National Team representing Canada at an International Level Event.
- 3) Been selected to an International Board or Committee.
