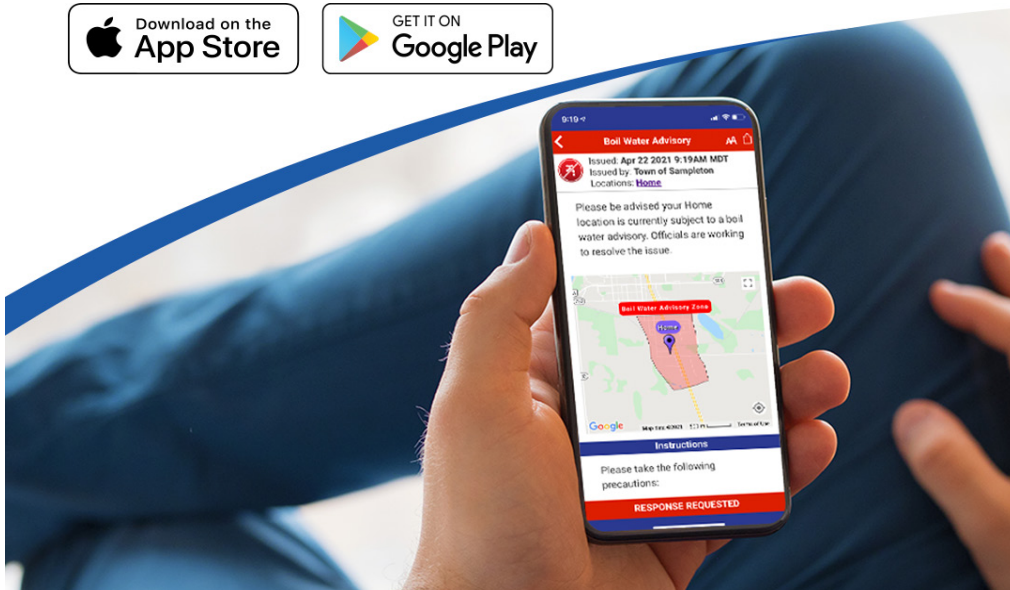

Voyent Alert! Is a multi-purpose service provided by the Town of Oromocto to keep you informed of critical events like fires or floods as well as day-to-day communications such as road maintenance and closures, sports facility closures, water advisories, etc.

Voyent Alert! allows you to create and follow multiple locations such as "Kids School" or "Mom's House". Any event or communication related to your followed locations will be forwarded to you along your preferred communication channel.

Smart alerting capabilities ensure that you will only get notified when a communication is relevant to you or one of the locations you are following.

CENTREFIT (PILATES)

OROMOCTO REGIONAL WELLNESS & RECREATIONAL CENTRE

The bid of MJMA/Acre Architects, in the amount of \$3,390,000 plus HST, was accepted for the provision of prime design services for the Oromocto Regional Wellness & Recreation Centre

EMPLOYMENT MATTERS

- Scott Rowe was promoted to the position of Deputy Fire Chief following the retirement of Deputy Chief Richard Cummings.
- The Town of Oromocto/IAFF Local 1576 ratified their respective agreement effective 1 Jan 2025 – 31 Dec 2028.
- Simon Eagle and Luke Doucette were hired as probationary Holiday Relief FF.
- Jayda Etienne and Shelley Smith were hired as an RCMP Detachment Service Assistants.
- John Lyons was hired as the Water and Sewer Supervisor.

RECYCLING DEPOT DISCONTINUED

On 1 May 2025 the Town of Oromocto transitioned its recycling depot program to the provincial household recycling program administered through Circular Materials. As part of that transition, Council authorized a gradual removal of the recycle depots. Effective 2 September, the final recycle depot, behind the Fire Station, will be removed.

LAND PURCHASE

Council approved a land purchase of 87 square metres in the amount of \$6415 for future land development of Cyr Street.

LAND SALE

The Mayor and CAO/Clerk be authorized to enter into a purchase and sale agreement with Wilde Properties Inc., for the sale of approximately 4,261 sq/m portion of PID 60158486 located in Oromocto West along the proposed Cyr Street Extension for the price of \$300,000 plus HST.

*No pickup on November 11


Ensure to have your yard waste articles at curbside no later than 7:00 AM on the Monday of your scheduled collection.
