YOUR OPPORTUNITY

The Oromocto Fire Department, a 54-member composite (combination) fire department, is seeking applications to establish an eligibility pool of qualified firefighters to fill any upcoming vacancies in our Holiday Relief Firefighter positions.

Reporting to the Officer, a Holiday Relief Firefighter responds to all emergency calls immediately as directed and performs a variety of rescue-related duties to protect the public and lessen the severity of injuries related to motor vehicle incidents, water hazards, confined space entrapment, etc. In addition to this, the Holiday Relief Firefighter takes part in non-emergency duties such as training exercises, maintenance duties to fire apparatus or equipment, and more. Filling of all future full-time positions will be from the Holiday Relief ranks.

The pay rate for this position is in accordance with the CBA plus vacation and stat pay with a guaranteed work schedule of 10 months averaging 42 hours per week. Other benefits are outlined in the CBA between the Town and IAFF Local 1576.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be legally entitled to work in Canada.
- Must possess a pardon if previously convicted of a criminal offense.
- Must show proof of High School Diploma or equivalent.
- Must show proof of successfully completed accredited "Gold Seal" Hazardous Materials Operations Level training.
- Must show proof of successfully completing accredited "Gold Seal" Firefighter II Training prior to the offer of employment
- Must show proof of certification in Medical First Responder or Emergency Medical Responder within 12 months of the date of application.
- Must possess a valid Province of New Brunswick driver's license.
- Must provide an original and valid Driver Abstract from the province of residence, which is current within 30 days of applying, and cannot show more than 5 demerit points, and no unpaid fines.

- Active membership with a Fire Department (municipal or equivalent) experience would be considered an asset.
- Technical Rescue Training (auto-ex, off-road, swift water, boat rescue, ice rescue, high-angle rope rescue, etc.) would be considered an asset.
- Personal health habits that develop and maintain resiliency.
- Ability to observe, identify, and communicate about mental health matters.
- Willingness to participate in mental health sessions and counseling for the development and maintenance of positive and resilient mental health.

COMPETITION

Prior to being offered a position with the department candidates:

- must show proof of possessing a valid NB Class 3 (endorsement E) driver's license (or equivalent).
- are subject to a police background check.
- must undergo a medical examination which indicates that there are no health issues that may affect job performance.
