DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Be attentive to customer needs and feedback with a focus on excellence in customer service and professionalism
- Assist boaters with general boating requirements including tying and fueling boats on arrival as well as pump out waste from vessels
- Responsible for accurate handling of payments and operating cash register
- Complete paperwork and required counts at the end of the shift
- Ability to work independently with little supervision
- As required perform minor repairs to work area such as docks and buildings
- Ensure the docks and equipment are operational at all times
- Maintain general cleanliness of the docks and equipment
- Ability to perform general labour tasks such as whipping, mowing, painting/staining and garbage collection
- Comply with OSHA/WHMIS and environmental regulations
- Other duties may be assigned

Safety orientation and any other specialized training related to the position will be provided.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Possession of a current Class 5 driver's license would be considered an asset.
- Must be full-time students, either entering or currently enrolled in post-secondary institutions for Fall 2025. Please include either confirmation of enrollment or proof of enrollment.
