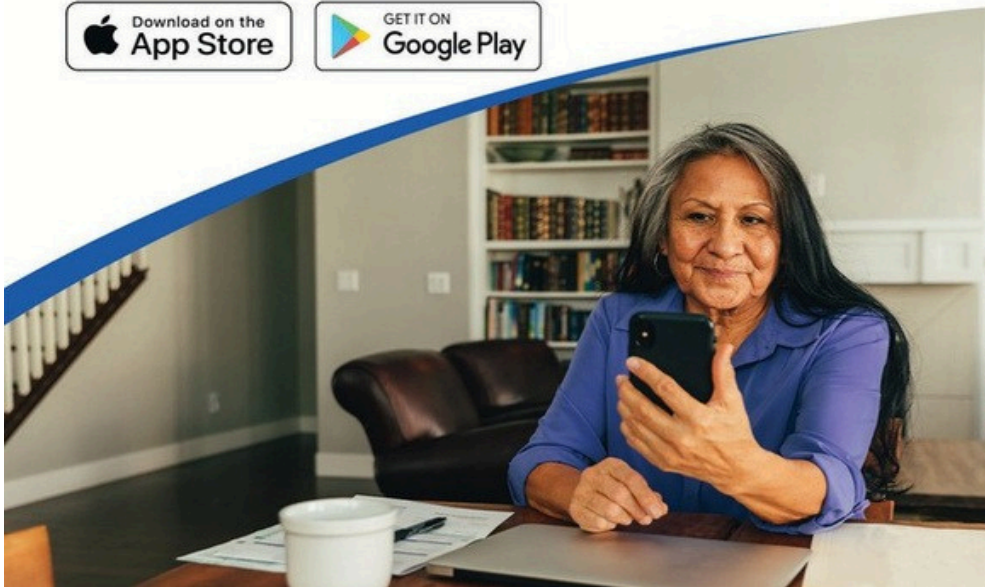

ALERT!?**

Voyent Alert! Is a multi-purpose communication service provided by the Town of Oromocto to keep you informed of critical events like fires or floods as well as day-to-day communications such as road maintenance and closures, sports facility closures, water advisories, etc. Voyent Alert! allows you to create and follow multiple locations such as "Kids School" or "Mom's House". Any event or communication related to your followed locations will be forwarded to you along your preferred communication channel. Smart alerting capabilities ensure that you will only get notified when a communication is relevant to you or one of the locations you are following. 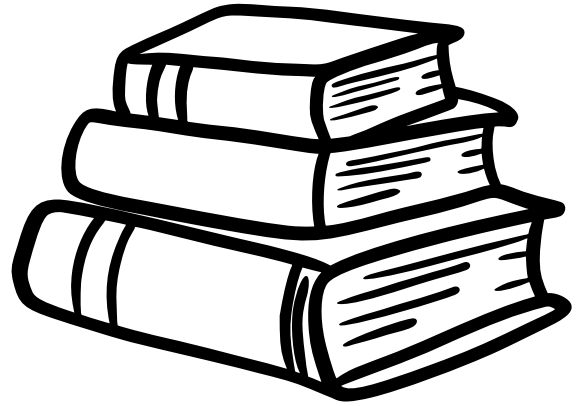


FAY TIDD PUBLIC LIBRARY INFORMATION CONTINUED...

Municipal Election

As part of the 70th Anniversary celebrations, the Town hosted a Trail Day at the Gaetway Wetlands and entered a parade float in the Canada Day Parade on July 1st. In addition, the annual Oromocto Pioneer Days Festival was held from 26 June- 4 July at the Hazen Park.

Oromocto Regional Wellness and Recreation Centre

Council approved the revised scope of services with MJMA/ Acre Architects, to support the phased implementation of the Oromocto Regional Wellness and Recreation Centre in the amount of \$377,475 (three hundred and seventy- seven thousand, four hundred and seventy-five dollars), plus HST.

Trail Barriers

Council authorized the Director of Recreation and Tourism to remove the jersey barriers and explore reasonable, non- restrictive alternatives to reduce motorized traffic on non-designated trails.

Basketball Net Installation at Coronation Park

The Director of Recreation and Tourism was authorized to expend approximately \$3,300 (three thousand, three hundred dollars) for the purchase and installation of a basketball net at Coronation Park. This was an unbudgeted expense.

Indigenous Services Canada/ Town of Oromocto Agreement Renewal

The Mayor and Chief Administrative Officer renewed the Municipal Services Agreement with Indigenous Services Canada on behalf of the Oromocto First Nation for 2026/2027.

Land Sales

Two parcels of Town-owned land were approved for sale by Council: 1) PID 60146388 (unserved) in the amount of \$110,000 plus HST, to the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure for a proposed new school site in Oromocto West and 2) a portion of PID 60189610, located at 6 Cyr Street, in the amount of \$130,000 plus HST to Dr. Jacob Jurnica and Dr. Samantha Solly for medical clinic.

Smith Subdivision UV Treatment and Equipment

Council authorized the expenditures of \$55,097.46, plus HST, for Smith Subdivision UV equipment and electrical upgrades.

Municipal Emergency Management Plan

Council accepted the quote received from Transitional Solutions Inc in the amount of \$61,390, plus HST and expenses, for the review and modernization of the Town of Oromocto's Municipal Emergency Management Plan, including associated training and exercise components.

Employment Matters

Council approved the following recommended appointment and hirings: Peter Wong, Director of Corporate Services, was appointed as the Town Treasurer; Adam Baxter was hired as the Director of Public Works; Matt Grant was hired as the Municipal Engineering Technologist and Connor Burt, Joshua Sheperd and Nolan MacLean have each been hired as a Holiday Relief Firefighter.



DEPARTMENT OF ENGINEERING AND PUBLIC WORKS

Yard Waste Drop-Off:

The Town of Oromocto's residents in Wards 1-4 can access a year-round organic yard waste drop-off site at the Department of Engineering and Public Works, 181 Black Watch Avenue.

We accept:

- Leaves and grass clippings ***Must be placed in compostable paper bags***
- Garden refuse and other similar items such as soil plants, sod, mulch, and woodchips
- Branches, limbs, sticks, and bushes
- **NO plastic bags or commercial dumping is allowed.**

Annual Hydrant Flushing:

The Town of Oromocto's annual Water Main Flushing Program takes place over the summer months and is currently planned for July-August. Flushing the water mains improves water quality by removing loose sediments and mineral deposits that slowly build up at the bottom of the watermain over time. The sediment comes from internal corrosion and mineral deposits that form along the pipe wall. This program is a cost-effective preventative maintenance measure, and part of the process to ensure continued high-quality drinking water in the Town. 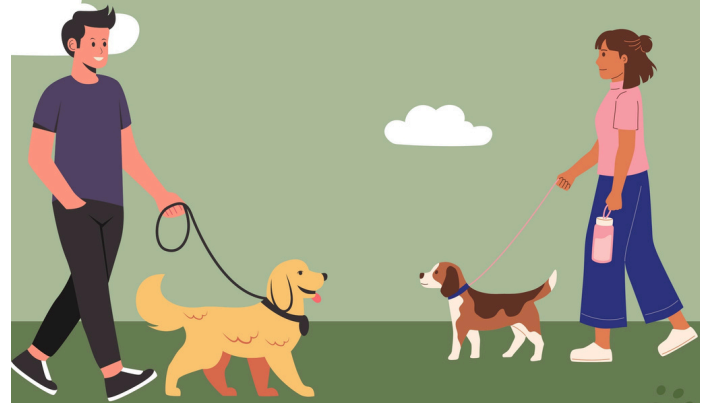
