In an effort to divert the volume of waste materials from the landfill, the Town will offer a leaf curbside collection of all residential households.

Acceptable Materials

Leaves ONLY in clear polyethylene plastic bags of 1.5 ml thickness with a maximum capacity of 55 litres securely tied at the top and not exceeding 20 kg (44 lbs) per bag.

Please do not place leaves at curbside in advance of November 5 and not after November 16.

> Yard waste can also be taken to the Fredericton Region Solid Waste Commission (1775 Alison Blvd.) during its normal hours of operation: Mon-Fri 7:30am - 5:00pm & Saturday 7:30 am - 3:00pm.
